Purpose of Position

The Director of Worship provides leadership and administrative support for our weekly worship services.

Requirements

Primary Duties & Responsibilities:

- Uphold the vision of Providence Church: *To glorify God by making disciples through the gospel, in community and on mission.*
- Serve as the primary worship leader in Sunday morning worship services, while also involving other musicians and worship leaders. Give oversight and leadership to other worship gatherings of the various ministries of Providence Church.
- Work closely with the Lead Pastor to develop weekly service plans that fit with the series theme; post service plans on Planning Center Online, including song lists, example recordings, chord charts, and other creative and liturgical elements.
- Recruit, audition, and train musicians and technical team.
- Schedule, rehearse, and communicate with volunteer musicians/vocalists for weekly gatherings.
- Prepare music that falls within the current musical and creative style of the church including both ancient and modern elements that provide historical rootedness in a modern stylistic context.

Expectations

- A faithful follower of Jesus Christ, actively seeking a deeper relationship with him.
- Fulfills the duties required of Providence Church covenant members as outlined in the membership covenant.
- Exhibits a servant’s heart for ministry to the body of Christ.
- Disciplined and diligent with their time, keeping a balance between home and work.

- Strong leadership skills; pastoral heart and love for people; ability to lead a team of volunteers and work effectively with staff and leadership teams.
- Strong verbal and written communication ability.
- Proficient in ProPresenter and Planning Center Online, and knowledgeable of sound equipment and mixing sound.

Direct Report: The Director of Worship reports directly to the Executive Pastor.
